Urban Forest Consultancy, Treeconomics, to open office in Sweden

Treeconomics, a UK company specialising in sustainable treescapes, has announced that it has signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) with Trädkontoret (The Tree Office), one of Sweden's leading consultancies in tree management. Kenton Rogers, Treeconomics' CEO, commented "We are excited to partner with Trädkontoret and expand our operations within Europe. This MOU formalises our shared commitment to innovation and sustainability in urban forestry."
